

2007 NSSE Results
Office of Institutional Effectiveness (OIE)

INTRODUCTION

This report summarizes the information from the results of the 2007 National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE). The report examines data from the survey sample population, examines the effect of the participation of adult, non-traditional students on the NSSE benchmark results for senior students, presents non-benchmark items in the areas of spirituality, relationships, and satisfaction and also provides trend information.

SAMPLE POPULATION

Mercer participated in the NSSE survey in 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, and 2007. Prior to 2006 Mercer surveyed Macon traditional students only. The 2007 NSSE is the second year that Mercer has included first-year and senior students from the Centers and Atlanta. For the 2007 survey, Mercer sent to NSSE the names and addresses of 1637 first-year and senior students. NSSE contacted 640 students of which 226 responded. Mercer's response rate of 35% compares favorably to the NSSE population response rate of 30%; however, only 17.3% of Mercer's first-year and 11.6% of senior students are represented by the 2007 results.

Since only two nursing students and zero business Atlanta students completed the survey, those schools are not considered beyond their inclusion in Table 1. Mercer's 2007 respondents closely resemble Mercer's total sample population with the exceptions that females and Caucasian students are over-represented in the respondent population. The over-representation of female students is consistent with the overall NSSE results and with widely reported survey research findings that conclude women are more likely than men to return questionnaires. NSSE BENCHMARKS

NSSE groups 42 of the 85 survey items into five benchmarks of educational engagement and calculates an overall score for each based on an 100 point scale. The five benchmarks are: *Level of Academic Challenge, Active and Collaborative Learning, Student-Faculty Interaction, Enriching Educational Experiences, and Supportive Campus Environment.*

External Benchmark Comparisons

NSSE provides benchmark comparison groups for our Carnegie Peers, all NSSE 2007 institutions, and the Top 50% and the Top 10% of NSSE institutions for each benchmark category. (See Appendix 1 for a list of our Carnegie Peers. A list of all NSSE 2007 institutions may be viewed at http://nsse.iub.edu/nsse_2007/2007-colleges.cfm. NSSE does not provide a list for the Top 50% or the Top 10% schools.)

Mercer's first-year and senior students rated their educational engagement across all five of the benchmark categories more highly than students at our Carnegie peers and at all NSSE institutions. Mercer's benchmarks are generally in line with the Top 50% scores. Mercer scored as well as or higher than the Top 10% in the category of Active and Collaborative Learning, but Mercer senior students ranked the Mercer experience lower in all other benchmark categories than did students included in the NSSE Top 10%.

Internal Benchmark Comparisons

Below are Mercer’s 2007 benchmark scores broken out by Macon traditional students and Center students. Both first year and senior Center students scored their educational engagement lower than did Macon traditional students in the areas of Level of Academic Challenge, Student-Faculty Interaction, and Enriching Education Experiences, but rated Supportive Campus Environment higher than did Macon students.

Of the 108 first-year respondents reported in *Table 1*, 93 (86%) are from the Macon campus traditional programs; however, only 64(54%) of the 118 senior respondents are Macon students. Thus the senior Center students have a significant impact on the benchmark results calculated and reported by NSSE. The senior benchmarks most influenced by the Center students are Student-Faculty Interactions, Enriching Educational Experiences and Supportive Campus Environment. Items included in the above benchmarks that demonstrate a significant difference between the means of traditional and Center senior students are listed below.

Student-Faculty Interaction

Worked with faculty members on activities other than coursework (1=never, 2=sometimes, 3= often, 4=very often)

Macon Undergraduate Benchmark Trends

Although Mercer has participated in the NSSE since 2002, only the years since 2004 are included in this report due to the fact in 2004, NSSE changed the

wording of numerous items so that prior years benchmark scores are not comparable. While the first year scores are reasonably stable the senior scores have shown a downward trend since 2004 in the areas of Level or Academic Challenge, Student-Faculty Interaction, and Supportive Campus Environment.

Center Undergraduate Benchmark Trends

NSSE results for Center students have only been available for the past two years. Due to the small numbers of first-year students and to the difference in the number of senior students responding (24 from 2006 to 2007) a comparative analysis would be premature. Of possible concern is the decline in Enriching Educational Experiences and Student-Faculty Interaction.

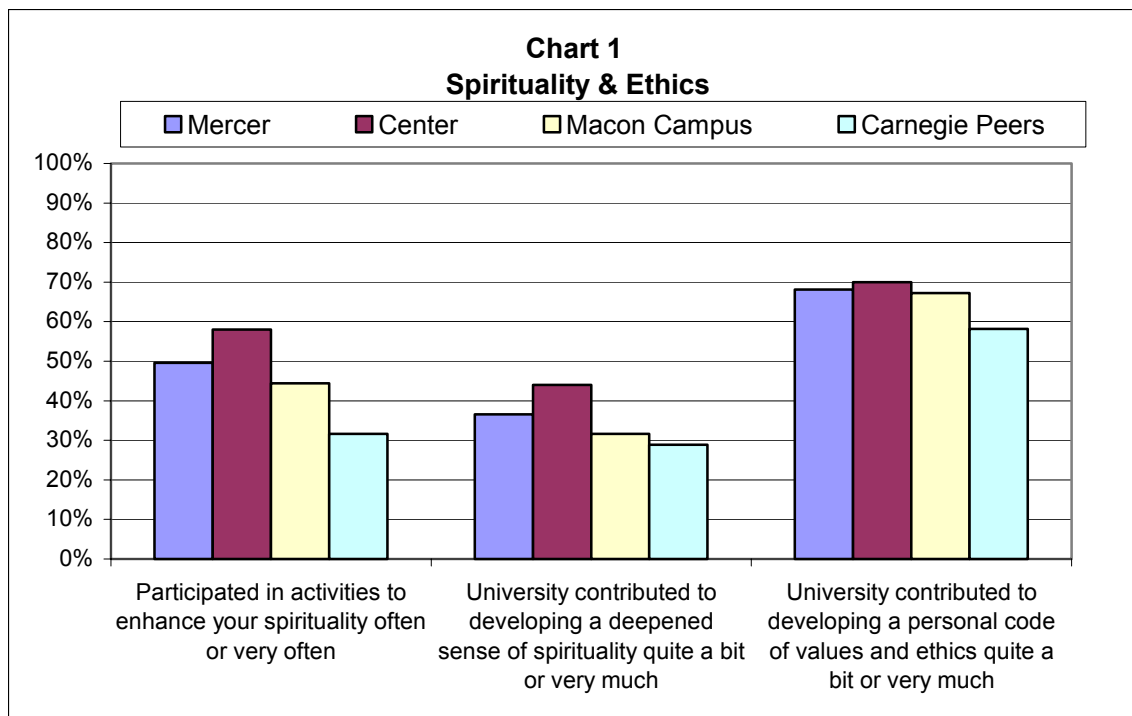

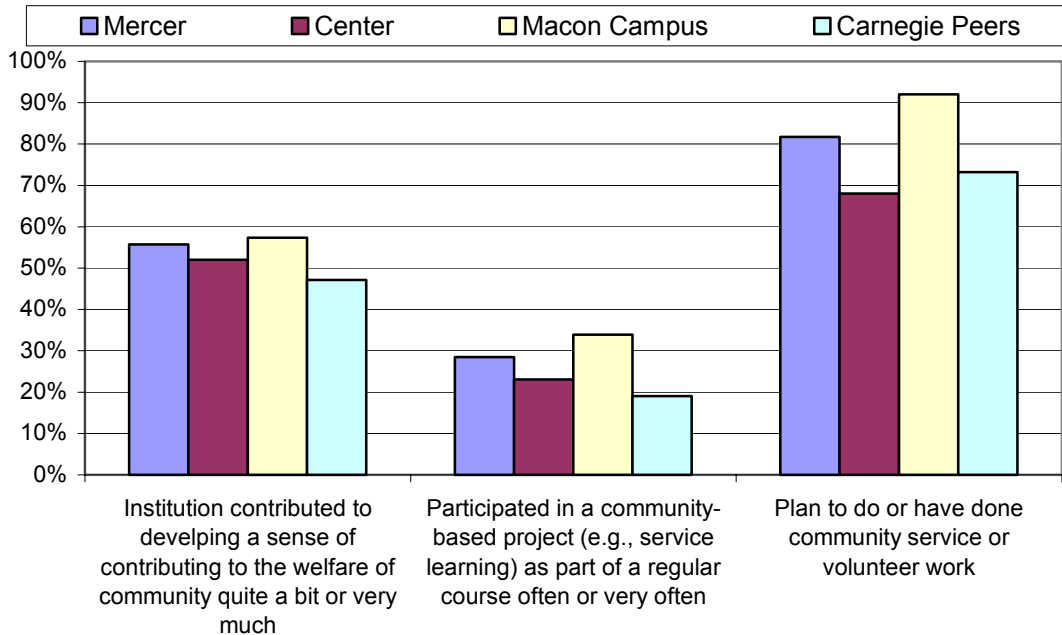
NON-BENCHMARK ITEMS

Not all NSSE items are included in the five benchmarks of engaged learning. For a full listing of NSSE items separated by Macon Traditional students and Center students, see Appendix 2. Below are charts demonstrating the difference in the areas of spirituality, community welfare, relationships, and satisfaction for senior students.

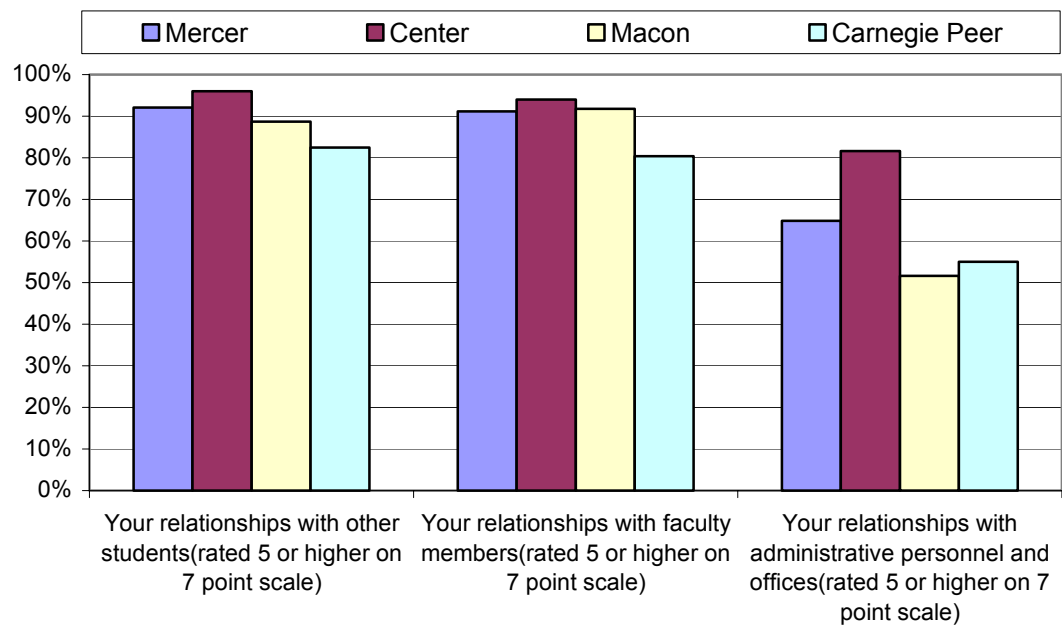
In all the above areas Mercer favorably compares with our Carnegie Peers. Interestingly, Center students rank spirituality and ethics items higher than do Mercer traditional students. Considerably more traditional students report that they have done or plan to do service or volunteer work. Both groups of students appear to be satisfied with their Mercer experience, although 10% more Center students report that they would definitely or probably would attend Mercer again. Both groups of students are satisfied with their student and faculty relationships, but Center students report a more positive relationship with administrative personnel.

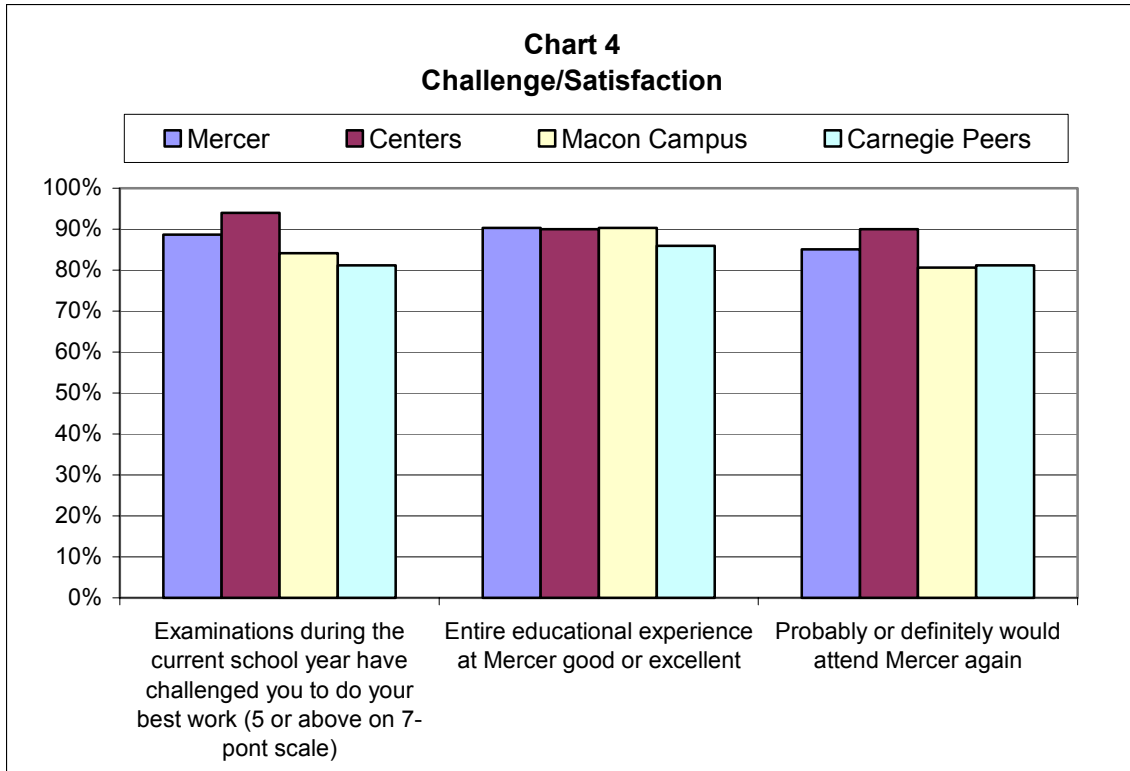


**Chart 2

CONCLUDING REMARKS

Please keep in mind that while NSSE encourages all institutions to publish their NSSE results, NSSE itself does not rank or allow college guides, newspapers, etc. to rank institutions based on their NSSE results. NSSE is not a direct measure of student learning outcomes. It does provide measures concerning the nature and quality of the student experience.

This report provides basic, internal comparisons that may be of use to administrators and student services staff. OIE will provide college level information to the deans; however the small percentage of students who respond to the NSSE has been an ongoing issue with desegregating the data to that level. In the spring of 2008, the NSSE will be available on-line to all eligible first-year and senior students. We hope to have a much higher percentage of students participate which will result in a richer source of data.

Finally, our trend data shows no relevant positive changes since we began the NSSE in 2002. We need to make a concentrated effort to use the NSSE data to improve the student experience at Mercer. Already this year OIE has presented NSSE data to the undergraduate council. As a member of the retention committee, the director in institutional research will provide pertinent information

to the committee regarding both the NSSE and the BCSSE (Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement). In the coming months OIE plans to meet with student services to discuss the NSSE and to hold a faculty lunch and learn to increase the awareness of the NSSE assessment of the student experience at Mercer University.
