IPEDS is based on all persons on the payroll of the institution as of November 1 (it does not include authorized positions that were not filled on Nov. 1).

The report is intended to provide a snapshot of human resources data at one point in the fall. Employees are counted only once even if employed in multiple categories. Includes employees at all locations and from all funding sources (restricted and unrestricted).

* The IPEDS surveys Fall Staff, Employees by Assigned Position, and Faculty Salaries were combined in 2005-06 and the instructions and definitions were refined. The "Instruction/Research/Public Service (with faculty status)" line is consistent with the "Faculty" line in the old IPEDS Staff report.

Mercer conducted an internal review of occupational category assignments in 2005 and reclassified a number of employees. Most of the movement was among the categories of "Executive/Admin and Managerial," "Other Professionals," and "Technical and Paraprofessionals."
