If you are accused of an infraction of the Honor Code, it is in your best interest to meet with the investigator(s) in order to learn of the charges brought against you, to examine the existing evidence, and to receive a copy of the Mercer University Honor Council Handbook. If a hearing is deemed necessary and you choose not to participate or to appear, you may be tried in absentia.
